

PERSONAL DATA RIGHTS

(GDPR DISCLAIMER)

In accordance with Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (General Data Protection Regulation – “GDPR”), data subjects have the following rights in relation to their Personal Data processed by Wisdompoint Capital Ltd (the “Company”):

1. Right to be Informed (Articles 13 and 14 GDPR)

You have the right to receive clear, transparent and easily accessible information regarding the collection and processing of your Personal Data, including the purposes of processing, categories of Personal Data processed, legal basis for processing, recipients of Personal Data, retention periods and your rights under GDPR.

2. Right of Access (Article 15 GDPR)

You have the right to obtain confirmation as to whether the Company processes your Personal Data and, where that is the case, to request access to such data together with information regarding the purposes of processing, categories of data concerned, recipients, retention period, and safeguards applied.

3. Right to Rectification (Article 16 GDPR)

You have the right to request the correction of inaccurate Personal Data and the completion of incomplete Personal Data.

4. Right to Erasure (“Right to be Forgotten”) (Article 17 GDPR)

You may request the deletion of your Personal Data where one of the grounds under Article 17 GDPR applies. For regulated entities, including Cyprus Investment Firms, certain Personal Data may be retained for periods prescribed by applicable legislation, including anti-money laundering and counter-terrorist financing legislation, financial services legislation, tax legislation, regulatory record-keeping obligations and other legal requirements. In such cases, the right to erasure may be restricted to the extent required by applicable law.

5. Right to Restriction of Processing (Article 18 GDPR)

You have the right to request restriction of processing in certain circumstances, including where you contest the accuracy of the data or object to processing pending verification of overriding legitimate grounds.

6. Right to Data Portability (Article 20 GDPR)

Where processing is based on consent or contract and carried out by automated means, you have the right to receive your Personal Data in a structured, commonly used and machine-readable format and, where technically feasible, to transmit those data to another controller.

7. Right to Object (Article 21 GDPR)

You have the right to object, at any time, to processing based on legitimate interests or for direct marketing purposes. Where Personal Data is processed for direct marketing, such processing shall cease upon objection.

8. Rights Related to Automated Decision-Making (Article 22 GDPR)

You have the right not to be subject to a decision based solely on automated processing, including profiling, which produces legal effects concerning you or similarly significantly affects you, unless permitted under GDPR and subject to appropriate safeguards.

9. Right to Withdraw Consent

Where processing is based on consent, you may withdraw your consent at any time. Withdrawal shall not affect the lawfulness of processing based on consent before its withdrawal. Please note that withdrawal of consent may affect the Company's ability to provide certain services.

10. Right to Lodge a Complaint

If you believe that your Personal Data is not processed in accordance with GDPR, you may submit a complaint to the Company at: support@wisdompointcapital.com
